Rent news: No increase for Council tenants

Good news for Council tenants: Wandsworth Council has completed its annual review of housing rents and agreed not to increase rents in April 2014. Last year Council rents were increased up to 4%. As mentioned in the November-December 2013 *Gazette*, Council tenants may see service charges listed on their rental bills, but these are calculated by the Council at the request of the Government and have no effect on your total rent.

Rents for non-residential units, i.e., storerooms and storesheds, will be increased by an average of 4%, the same as last year. Affected renters will receive a letter stating the increase. Please ensure that any standing orders are amended to reflect the new rent charges.

New gas piping to be installed in Allenswood and Fernwood

Residents of Allenswood and Fernwood may already have received a letter from Southern Gas Networks to inform them of essential works to be carried out on their blocks in the next few months. The project is part of a national programme to replace old gas mains and services before they reach the end of their useful lives, in order to ensure a safe and reliable supply of gas. A risk analysis of Wimbledon Park showed Allenswood and Fernwood to be the first priorities, but the other blocks will follow. Scaffolding will be erected on the blocks in order to place the new piping.

Southern Gas Networks contractors will require access to each flat in Allenswood and Fernwood. Please be sure to ask to see identification before letting anyone into your property.
